## Admission Requirements

- The basic admission requirements for any postgraduate student applying for a programme at the University of Nairobi can be accessed on this [page](#) [10].
- Degree certificates and transcripts presented for consideration should be certified by the issuing institutions.
- Translation of certificates not in English is mandatory for ease of processing.
- Degree certificates and transcripts of institutions not accredited should be subjected to a verification process by the Commission of Universities Education (CUE)
- Documents such as Kenya pupil's pass, commitment letter, valid passport etc should be available.

## Fees payment

Different programmes have different fees structures depending on the field of study i.e Arts, Sciences, Clinicals, Medicine etc. Foreign students outside the partner states of the Northern Corridor Integration Projects (Republics of Burundi, Rwanda, Uganda and South Sudan) are required to pay an additional 25% in dollars on all charges stated in a programmes' fees structure.

However, some disciplines indicate their payment in dollars (\$) for ease of payment.
